





The collective, based in Barcelona, celebrates five years on stage and consolidates with the second album, "Come Shine" (Brixton Records, 2021)



Drop Collective was born at the end of 2016 with the idea of exploring the paths that join **Jamaican music and jazz**, and the unique possibilities offered by a five-horn section.

After the success of "Stormin" (La Panchita Records, 2018), where the collective presented a repertoire of jazz standards, they open a new stage where they also incorporate original songs.

In the hope that music will help bring light to the times we live in, they present:

"Come Shine" was recorded in February 2021 at Estudis Ground marked by the impact of the pandemic. Live, they present all 10 songs from the album, combined with songs from "Stormin'" and others unique to the live show. The **total duration is 70 min** customizable.





Of everything that happened in the first five years of history, we must highlight:

In **2016** they recorded the first two songs.

In **2017** they **presented the project** to the public at the Koitton Club de Sants, then they performed in places such as the Estival de Jazz d'Igualada, Nowa Reggae and the Ítaca de l'Empordà Festival where they met Dr. Ring Ding, whom you will find collaborating in his first album. The same year they received a grant from the Cases de la Música to **record Stormin'**. A Verkami with more than 120 patrons made the project possible.

During **2018 and 2019** they did the Stormin' tour that took them, among other places, to the Barcelona Jazz Festival, the Festes de la Mercè, the Nits de Jazz de la Pedrera, Festes del Tura d'Olot, Andorra and many others. In February **2020** they fired Stormin' with a full Jamboree and the "**Jamaicat**" compilation (Liquidator Records, 2020) was published, where they contributed the song "What a difference".

In **autumn 2020** they presented a new video clip and a new live show at the **Fira de la Mediterrània** in Manresa.
